What is Hospice Care?

Anyone suffering from a serious illness or disease who has been given 6 months or less to live can enter into hospice care. In hospice care, a team of nurses, doctors, aides, and volunteers work together to enhance the quality of life for each patient. The goal is not to stop or slow the illness but to provide comfort and support to those who are suffering and their loved ones.

In-Home Hospice Care

The comfort of your home, the compassion of our care. That's what Faith Hospice promises and provides. Our physicians, nurses and aides are trained and specialized in hospice care—each delivering the medical care needed with love and compassion. Additionally, we're able to offer a number of care-related support services—volunteers

Trillium Woods Facility

Faith Hospice is one of the few hospice organizations in West Michigan to offer the option of a warm and welcoming hospice inpatient facility. Whatever the need, whether it's a short-term stay that focuses on treatments so patients can return home more comfortably, a more long-term stay or respite stays to relieve caregivers, Trillium Woods offers a peaceful, family-centered atmosphere with 24/7 medical care. Trillium Woods also offers a non-denominational chapel for worship, prayer or meditation.



Pastoral Services
